Joys and Concerns The recent immigration law passed by the Arizona state legislature and signed by the governor has raised significant concern across the nation. Our particular family of faith, the Pacific Southwest Mennonite Conference, is composed of many recent immigrants and this legislation has caused a ripple of concern and fear around our area churches. The PSMC has decided to go ahead and hold our previously planned Summer Assembly in Phoenix this June 18-19, as scheduled. We anticipate that actions will be taken by the delegates at that time in response to the legislation. As a congregation and as a larger peoplehood, we stand in solidarity with all immigrants.

Summer Visitors to FMC This summer we will welcome a number of summer workers. Sarah Pohl, a current Bethel College junior, will be here for the entire summer participating in the Ministry Inquiry program sponsored by Mennonite colleges. She will have a variety of pastoral and ministry experiences during the summer months.
